This is why Secop just has released two new types of environment-friendly compressors that use propane as refrigerant for the North and Central American Market.

TL-CNX.2, NL-CNX.2 and SC-CNX.2 compressors for 115V/60 Hz are the perfect choice for bottle coolers, commercial refrigerators and freezers. Operating at full low back pressure (LBP) to medium back pressure (MBP) range they can be also used in a variety of other solutions – food service equipment, dispensers, vending machines, etc.

Moreover, Secop is about to extend the program with the release of another series of R290 (propane) compressors for the European/Asian market. These are DLE-MNX/DLE-CNX and NLE-MNX/NLE-CNX compressors. They are tailored for commercial use and are able to replace the compressors for R404A and R134a. With any of these compressors Secop meets the demand for natural refrigerants with a very low global warming potential (GWP).
